Program Requirements

To qualify for the degree of **Bachelor of Health Sciences (Advanced)**, the student must complete satisfactorily a program of study consisting of the following courses with a combined total of not less than 72 units, comprising:

- Level I Health Science courses to the value of at least 12 units, which may include the Core courses and Closed electives
- Level II Health Science courses to the value of at least 12 units, which may include the Core courses and Closed electives
- Level III Health Science courses to the value of at least 12 units, which may include the Core courses and Closed electives
- Core courses to the value of 24 units
- A major from the following: Epidemiology; Human Reproductive Health; Nutrition
- Elective courses up to the value of 24 units, which may include closed and open electives.
- Broadening Electives to the value of 9 units.
- Students may choose to complete a second Major from the Advanced Degree Majors or from the following Majors available
 in the Bachelor of Health Sciences: Anatomical Sciences; Biochemistry; Exercise Science; Genetics; Health Promotion;
 Indigenous Health; Microbiology; Neuroscience; Pathology; Pharmacology; Physiology
