## HEALTHY STAFF CLINIC PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Healthy Staff Clinic conducted by the School of Nursing uses a Filemaker™ database to collect and store patient's personal information and primary health screening data. This database is securely stored on a server hosted by the University of Adelaide. Information on the database will only be accessible by the Nurse Practitioner and limited authorised staff of the University. Students assisting in the Healthy Staff Clinic may only enter patient data into the data base in the presence of the individual undergoing the Health Check and the Nurse Practitioner. Students will not be able to access other patient data.

Each patient's personal and health information will only be used by the University for the purposes of undertaking the health check. The University will not disclose a patient's personal or health information to a third party except with the patient's consent, or otherwise as required or authorized by law. The University may use aggregated and de-identified data used for research or audit purposes.
